

Team Captain Position Description

Overview

The Team Captain is primarily responsible for organising the team for success on match days.

Core Responsibilities

- Act in accordance with the ECC Selection and Participation Policy.
- ➤ Attend Selection Committee Meetings / contribute to selection.
- Organise use of covers on match day.
- ➤ Conduct pre-match ground inspection.
- Manage the on-field performance of the team on match day.
- Organise awarding of Wickas Trophy votes.
- Ensure match reporting is carried out in accordance with VSDCA requirements.

Additional Responsibilities

- ➤ Model Spirit of Cricket behaviour and ensure adherence by team members.
- > Welcome and provide orientation to visiting teams.
- > Ensure all players contribute to maintaining facilities in a clean and neat condition, whether home or away.
- Liaise with Senior Coach to ensure player development needs are met by training program.
- > Provide match summary on selection nights.
- > Provide captains report for Club Annual Report.

Knowledge and Skills Required

- ➤ Understand the Laws of Cricket and VSDCA Pennant Rules.
- ➤ Understand the Cricket Australia bowling limitations for underage players.
- ➤ Understand VSDCA player caution and reporting procedures.
- Understand match day tactics.
- ➤ Knowledge of team members abilities and capabilities.
- ➤ Aware of VSDCA requirements regarding match reporting and timelines.
- > Proficient in use of MyCricket functionality relevant to playing and match reporting.
- > Proficient in use of MyCricket Live Score App, specifically Duckworth-Lewis functionality.

Personal Qualities

- > Effective leader and communicator.
- ➤ Ability to organise and delegate tasks.

Qualifications

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- > Required Working With Children Check.
- > Preferred First Aid Certificate.
