Overview

The Curator is primarily responsible for preparation and maintenance of wickets on Elsternwick Park Ovals No.1 and No.2.

Core Responsibilities

- Pre-season activities to aid in establishing a playing surface on the wicket square.
 - Interface with Council Contractor during post-football wicket table renovation.
 - Additional seeding and fertilising as deemed applicable.
 - Coordinate with volunteers for laying of “growth mats”.
 - Wicket table watering and mowing.
 - Cross-rolling as deemed applicable.
- Preparation of wickets in season.
- Wicket table mowing, fertilising, weed treatment and wicket recovery activities
- Liaise with Captains / Players in relation to covers application and post-match activities
- Wicket marking & line marking for one-day / T20 games.
- Match day duties as applicable (liaise with captains).
- Coordinating activities as required with club volunteers (eg additional watering, rolling etc).
- Liaise with Facilities / Equipment Manager regarding equipment needs and maintenance.
- Liaise with Facilities Manager regarding automated irrigation requirements.

Additional Responsibilities

- Provide guidance and mentorship to other curators and volunteers at the Club.

Knowledge and Skills Required

- Excellent understanding of cricket wicket preparation and maintenance.
- Ability to operate equipment in a safe manner.
- Basic mechanical knowledge.

Personal Qualities

- Effective communicator.
- Ability to organise and delegate tasks.

Qualifications

- Desirable - Formal qualification in Turf Management.
